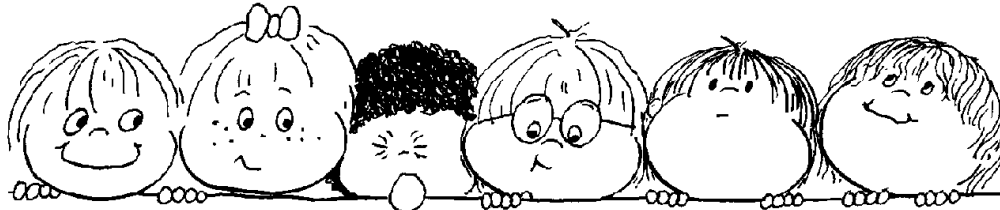

**We just want to remind you of the following things when preparing for training:**

# How to Register

## Registration / Cancellations

- Advanced telephone registration is required for all sessions. NO ON-SITE registrations are accepted.
- If for any reason you cannot attend a class you have registered for, please give us a call as soon as possible to cancel so that someone else can benefit from that seat.

## Payment

1. There is no fee for training sessions for providers that accept funding from the Child Care Assistance Program.
2. Participants employed at centers that do not receive CCAP payments must pay \$10.00 per two hours of training.
3. All providers must e-mail or mail in registration form and payment (if applicable) for the registration process to be complete. When we receive your form, you will receive a confirmation notice. If your registration form is not received within 5 days, you will be dropped from the session.

## Training

- Participants must attend the **entire session**.
- **No one is admitted 10 minutes** after the start of a class.
- **Children** are not allowed at training sessions.
- **Identification** may be checked before certificate can be issued.

In the event that a scheduled training session needs to be cancelled, registrants will be notified either by telephone, mail or email.

**Support Resources & Services**

The Partnerships in Child Care office is eager to offer many kinds of support to you and your staff members!

**Resource Center**

Our Resource Center is open during our regular business hours, 8:00 am – 4:00 pm Monday through Friday, as well as one Saturday morning each month, for your convenience. Staff is available to provide assistance to you in using the resources we have available. Our resources include

- Die Cuts: over 400 letters, numbers, shapes, animals, holiday images, and other figures, in different sizes which you can use to make posters, books, matching games, and other learning tools
- Poster Printers: useful for printing information for parents for your parent board
- Lamination: low-cost lamination for helping keep your signs, posters, folder games, or other learning tools stronger for longer
- Books: a rich library of books with information on child care and ideas for activities to support early learning
- Free Resources: donations we receive (such as calendar pictures, artificial flowers, yarn, and other craft materials) that you can use for learning projects with the children in your care

**Training Opportunities**

Want to learn more about how young children develop and how to support healthy development? Want help in addressing behavior challenges more effectively? Want ideas for working more effectively with families? If so, sign up for one of our free PICC training classes through our regular training flyer! Trainings are held weekday evenings or on Saturdays and count toward your required number of annual trainings; trainings cover a range of topics from early learning and development standards, to assessing and scaffolding children's learning, to behavior management, to professionalism and working on the CDA.

Centers can also contract and pay for trainings to be held on-site, during a time of the center's choosing.

**One-on-One Technical Assistance**

Remember that you can contact one of our staff members by phone or e-mail at any time to ask any questions you may have about child care, child development, early learning, state regulations, discount opportunities, creative ideas for low-cost learning materials, and more!

**Peer Support**

Join PICC staff and other child care providers to ask questions and learn creative and practical solutions for your work. Directors' Network meetings are held approximately once every two months, usually on the first Tuesday of a month, from 12:30-2:00 pm, with clock hours given to Directors for attendance.

**Parent Support**

Our parent support specialist offers free small group sessions for parents on topics such as The Power of Positive Parenting, Raising Confident and Competent Children, and Raising Resilient Children and one-on-one sessions for parents on a wide range of topics from bedtime problems to tantrums to sharing to whining and more.
