



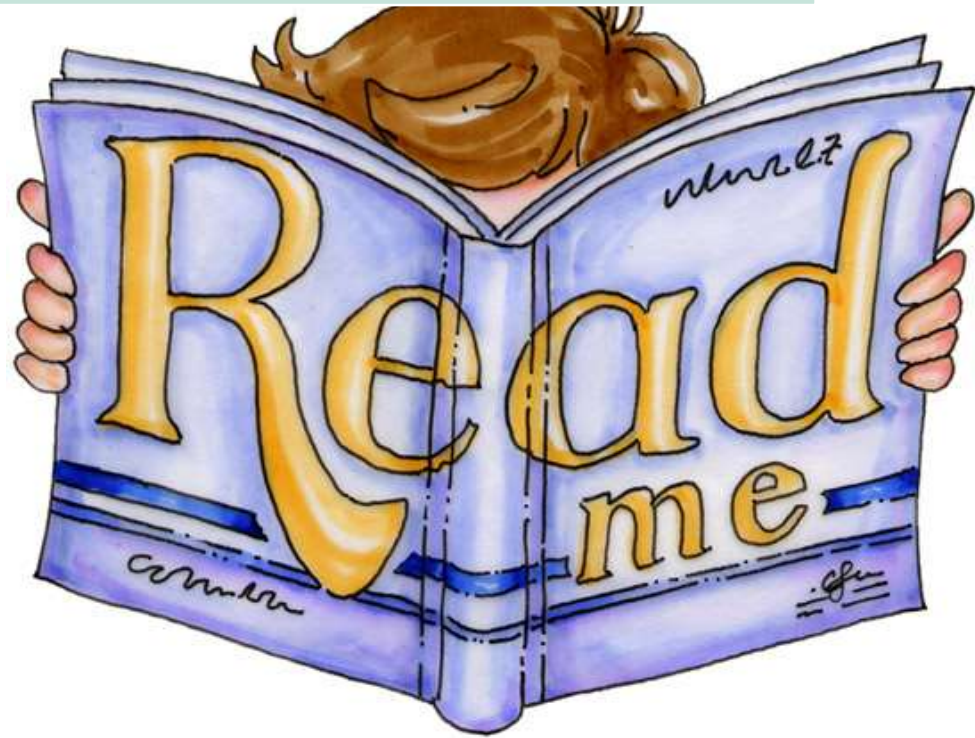

Registration/Cancellations:

- Registration forms must be completed and returned to Volunteers of America PICC
- Registrations may be mailed, faxed, or emailed.
- **Classes close on the Tuesday before the training at 12:00 p.m.,** no registrations will be accepted after this time. Also, any changes need to be made before this time. The packets are printed and sent to the trainings at this time and any changes made will not be reflected on the sign-in sheets or certificates.
- If for any reason you cannot attend a class you have registered for, please give us a call as soon as possible. This is important for both trainings that may not have enough participants, as well as trainings that are full. Please be mindful that when you register you are taking up a slot that could otherwise go to someone else if you cannot make it.

Payment:

- There is no fee for training sessions for providers that accept funding from the Child Care Assistance Program.
- Participants employed at centers that do not receive CCAP payments and Type I and II child care centers, must pay \$10.00 per three hours of training.
- All providers must email or mail in registration form for the registration process to be complete. When we receive your form, you will receive an e-mail with a confirmation if you were registered. If the class is full you will receive an email stating that we were unable to register you.

Training:

- Participants must attend the entire session.
- No one admitted 15 minutes after the start of a class

Children are not allowed at training sessions

- Identification may be checked before certificate can be issued.

In the event that a scheduled training session needs to be cancelled, registrants will be notified either by telephone or email.
