



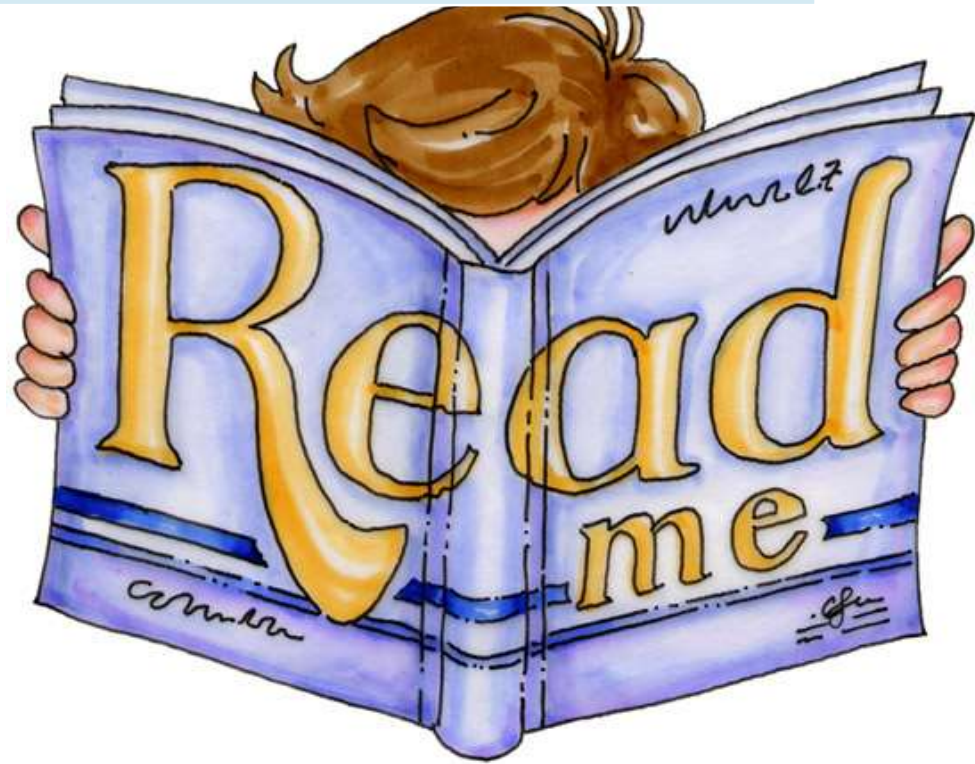

- **All providers must email or mail in registration form for the registration process to be complete. When we receive your form, you will receive an e-mail with a confirmation if you were registered. If the class is full you will receive an email stating that we were unable to register you.**

- **Participants must attend the entire session.**
- **No one admitted 15 minutes after the start of a class**

**Children are not allowed at training sessions**

- **Identification may be checked before certificate can be issued.**
