



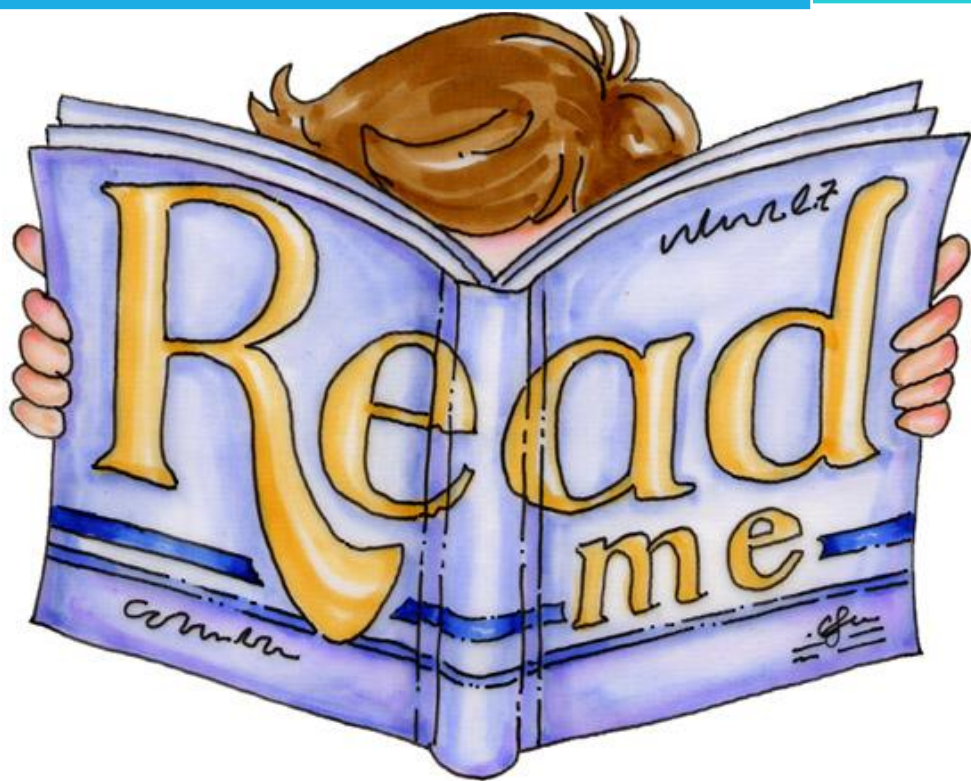

- Children are not allowed at training sessions
- Identification may be checked before certificate can be issued.
