



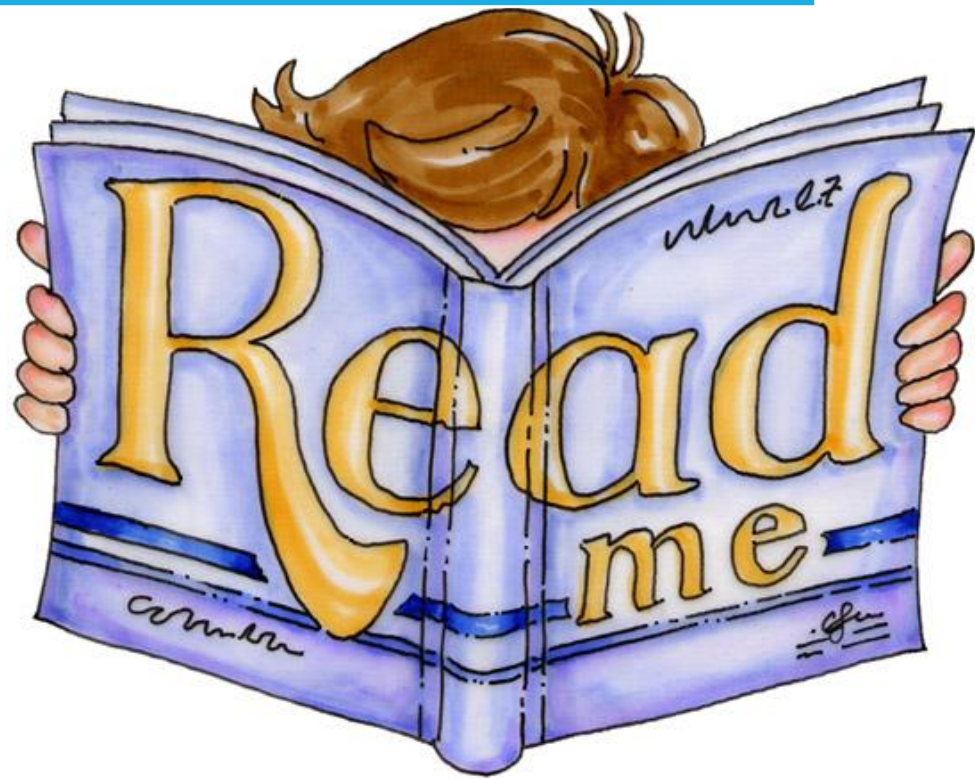

- All providers must email or mail in registration form for the registration process to be complete.

Training:

- Participants must attend the entire session.
- No one admitted 15 minutes after the start of a class

Children are not allowed at training sessions

- Identification may be checked before certificate can be issued.
