



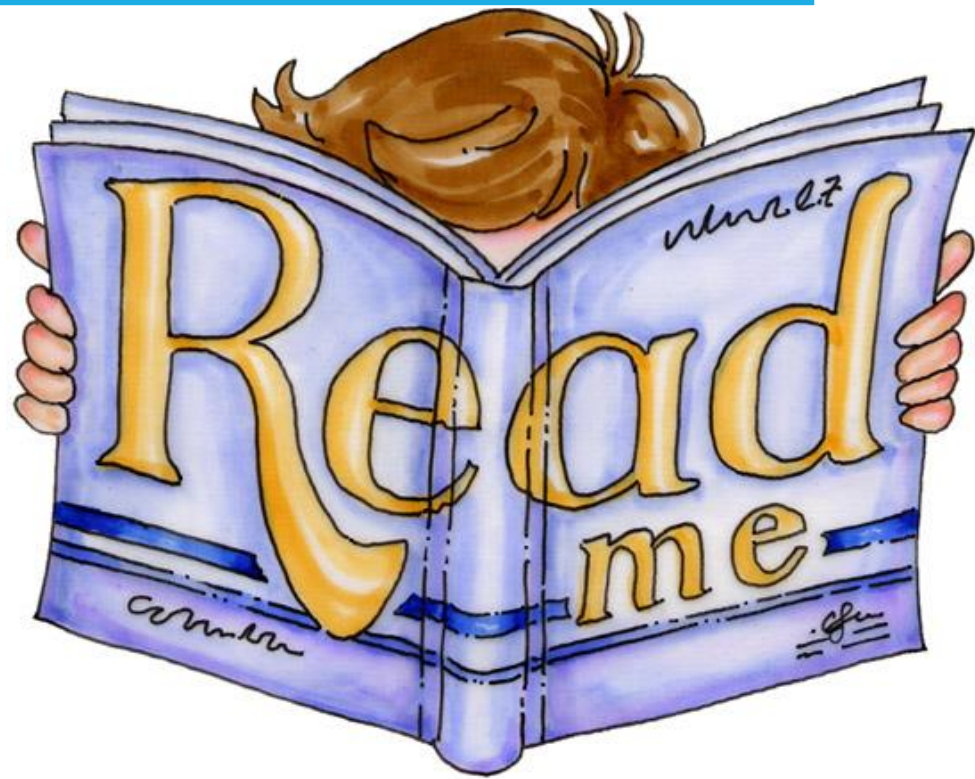

- No one admitted 15 minutes after the start of a class

Children are not allowed at training sessions

- Identification may be checked before certificate can be issued.
