



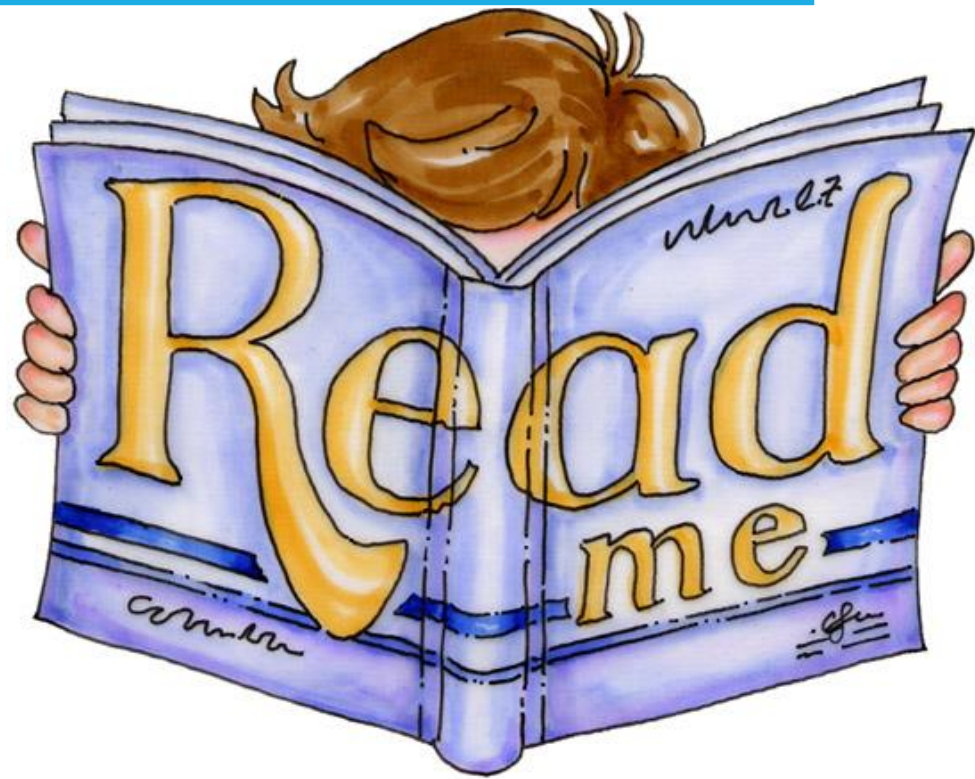

Payment:

- There is no fee for training sessions for providers that accept funding from the Child Care Assistance Program.
- Participants employed at centers that do not receive CCAP payments and Class B child care centers, must pay \$10.00 per three hours of training.
- All providers must email or mail in registration form for the registration process to be complete. When we receive your form, you will receive a confirmation notice. If your registration form is not received within 3 days, you will be dropped from the session.

Training:

- Participants must attend the entire session.
- No one admitted 15 minutes after the start of a class

Children are not allowed at training sessions

- Identification may be checked before certificate can be issued.

In the event that a scheduled training session needs to be cancelled, registrants will be notified either by telephone or email.
